Recently revised after extensive piloting, the 3rd Edition of LTAT is ready to launch. LTAT Educator Trainings are delivered across the province by Certified LTAT Trainers.

- Early Childhood Educator or Primary Teacher certification (or equivalent experience).
- Strong facilitation skills to engage adult learners in a supportive and culturally affirming environment.
- Openness to continuous learning and professional development.
- Experience delivering the LTAT Children's Program is an asset, but not required.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

- **Start Date:** February 2025
- **Commitment:** Online training sessions with the potential for in-person shadowing and mentoring.
- **Completion:** Certified LTAT Trainers may be contracted to co-facilitate LTAT Educator Trainings in their home community or elsewhere in the province.
- **Supports provided:** Travel expenses, accommodation, and honorariums provided for in-person activities. Professional development certificates will be provided for all online sessions.
