






# Second Highest Poverty Rate in Canada



# Inequality

BC has largest gap between rich and poor in Canada



- Unequal societies have more health and social problems
- Tax and transfer system not reducing inequality as much as previously

# Most Poor People are Working

- ▶ 100,000 people in Metro Van are working poor
- Yet earnings are not enough to lift them and their children out of poverty



### FACTSHEET 5: CHILD POVERTY AND WORKING PARENTS



Increases in Family Median Income vs. Increases in Family Costs, 2007-2014

Child care up 35%

Rent up 26%

Basic family costs up 18%

Income up 10%



Between 2007 and 2014, increases in family incomes fell far short of increases in family costs.

# Deep Poverty







- Welfare = inadequate & inaccessible
- Welfare = \$610/month (\$983 if you have a recognized disability)
- Systematically discouraged, delayed and denied





### Percentage Reduction in Child Poverty Rates in 2014 Due to Government Transfer Payments








